It has been a fabulous week! In Reading the First Graders are working on an animal research project. They are in the beginning of the process as they choose their topic and together we will research different aspects about the animal, its adaptations and environment. One group of Kindergarteners are working on character analysis as they chose a character from our story, "The Cupcake Party" and used descriptive language to tell about them. The other group is working with decoding and synthesizing CVC words in the text and in their writing. In Math the First Graders are working with double digit addition with regrouping. The Kinders are continuing their study of geometry as they explore both 2D and 3D shapes all in our world. In Science we will begin a unit on living and nonliving things as we explore the world around us. In Social Studies we are working with things in our community and community helpers. As part of our unit we talked about train conductors and their job as we had a great train trip to Montauk and visited the lighthouse and its surrounding area.
